- ✓ Over 18 years old
- ✓ Receiving IV cancer treatment

Why Take Part?

- ✓ Fewer needle sticks:

 Ultrasound may help get your drip in first try.
- ✓ More comfortable: Especially if your veins are hard to find.
- ✓ Improve care for others: Your participation helps future patients!



How It Works:

Randomly assigned to:

- Traditional method (nurse uses touch/sight).
- Ultrasound-guided method (tiny scanner finds veins easily).

Takes the same time as a normal drip insertion.

No Extra Risks – Just Potential Benefits!

Your treatment stays the same – only the insertion method changes.
