Advanced Entry - Year 2

Advanced entry into the Master of Education (School Leadership or Special and Inclusive Education strand) is available to candidates who have successfully completed the Postgraduate Diploma in School Leadership (PDSL/DGCS) or the Postgraduate Diploma in Special Educational Needs (PGDSEN) within the last 5 years. There are limited places on both MEd strands, so early application is advisable.
