### Candidate Statement / Ráiteas an Iarrthóra

With a strong background in education, media, journalism, film-making and theatre, I believe that I am well-placed to represent your views on the ultimate decision-making body which will shape University of Galway's future.

As a student in the late 1980s and 90s and as a staff member for the past 15 years, I have experienced the ups and downs from both a student and staff perspective. I'm a good communicator, fluent in Irish and English and do not shy away from public speaking. I have sat on and chaired various boards.

I would love to bring my skills and experience to this forum, to convey ideas and aspirations of staff and students, to act as an agent for change and a better University of Galway.

I have a sense of the changes coming about in a university's role in society, how students access education, the ever increasing need to link university courses with the workplace. I am



convinced that it is through further strategic partnerships that the University will grow and flourish.

There is room to align more closely with the State's strategy for providing more services through the medium of Irish between now and 2030. Stronger links could be forged with the Technological Universities which might augment some of our course offerings as well as cutting down on duplication.

In 2022 I was part of a delegation which represented University of Galway in Denver, Colorado at NAFSA: Association of International Educators. I have an appreciation of the importance in attracting students from other countries to study in Galway and a sense of the potential that is out there.

I would welcome this opportunity to be part of the Governing Body and play a part in making the case for more resources for our University and for a better future.

Creidim go láidir san fhiúntas a bhaineann leis an obair dheonach, faoi láthair táim i mo chathaoirleach ar thógra i gCo. an Chláir a théann i ngleic leis an athrú aeráide. Tá talamh ceannaithe ag Tearmann Dúlra Loch Gréine i ndúthaigh an fhile Brian Merriman chun an bhithéagsúlacht a chur chun cinn agus chun oideachas faoin dúlra a chur ar dhaoine óga agus ar dhaoine fásta araon.

Tá tuiscint áirithe agam ar na hathruithe atá ag teacht ar ról ollscoile sa phobal agus an gá atá ann le leasuithe sa chóras oideachais trí chéile. Tá beirt mhac sna déaga agam, oileadh sa lámhscríbhneoireacht iad ach is ar éigean go mbeirfidh ceachtar acu ar pheann go deo arís!

D'fhéadfadh an Ollscoil oibriú taobh le straitéis an Stáit níos mó seirbhísí trí mheán na Gaeilge a sholáthar idir seo agus 2030. B'fhéidir go mbeadh sé chun tairbhe na hearnála in iarthar tíre go mbeadh níos mó oibriú as lámh a chéile leis na hOllscoileanna Teicneolaíochta. Is trína thuilleadh páirtnéireachtaí straitéiseacha a thiocfaidh fás agus forbairt ar an Ollscoil s'againne.

Ghlacas páirt i dtoscaireacht de chuid Ollscoil na Gaillimhe in 2022 go Denver, Colorado chuig NAFSA: Cumann na nOideachasóirí Idirnáisiúnta. Thug an chuairt seo léargas dom ar thábhacht na mac léinn ó thíortha eile don Ollscoil s'againne agus ar an spéis mhór atá amuigh ansin in Éirinn agus i gcúrsaí oideachais anseo.

Ba bhreá liom an deis seo a fháil tionchar a imirt ar fhás agus ar forbairt na hOllscoile amach anseo trí bhur smaointe a bhreith chuig Údarás na hOllscoile.

Is éisteoir maith mé agus caithim dúthracht le gach a dheinim. Bheinn mar ghuth foirne ar Údarás na hOllscoile ag malartú smaointe agus ag imirt tionchair ar mhunlú Ollscoil na Gaillimhe do na glúnta atá fós le teacht.
