Reducing the temperature and duration of heating systems:

The following actions will be implemented from 1ST October 2024 and extended to May 2025.

1. Heating times in teaching and offices space will be as follows:

Monday to Friday – (7am to 11.00am) and ( 2.00pm to 5.00pm)
Saturday – (8am to 12noon) and ( 3.00pm to 5.30pm)
Sunday – (8am to 12noon) and ( 3.00pm to 5.30pm)

- 2. Heating times in Research spaces will be reviewed based on activity but will follow the time schedules above.
- 3. Hot water will be enabled to run between 9.00am and 5.00pm daily, reduced hours at the weekend.
- 4. Temperature set points as advised by Government.
 - 19 degrees for all offices, teaching spaces and laboratories.
 - 17 degrees for toilets.
 - No heat will be turned on in corridors.
 - All air conditioning units except for Comms/Data centers will be turned off.
 - Humidity levels will be maintained in Laboratory spaces.



The heating is weather compensated by the Building Management System and therefore will be adjusted automatically.
