## Entry requirements & English Language

- ✓ First year of study completed
- ✓ Good standing with home institution
- ✓ Full and complete application and supporting documents
- ✓ **Minimum GPA 2.75 (or country equivalent)**
- ✓ **For Full year Study Visa students: IELTS: 5.5 (no individual element below 5.5)** or other acceptable English tests (*found on <https://www.edgehill.ac.uk/departments/support/international/english-language-requirements/>*)
- ✓ **For 1 semester students:** must be able to study fully in English and have already studied at university level in English

\*The Study Abroad programme is taught fully in English.

\*\*All applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis and circumstances which may have affected a student's GPA will be taken into consideration

## Accommodation

- ✓ On campus accommodation is not guaranteed for Erasmus students – if we have availability, you will be contacted to apply but you may need to look for private accommodation.
- ✓ Accommodation on and off campus for semester only students can be difficult to obtain so please leave plenty of time to arrange appropriate accommodation.
- ✓ If there is on campus accommodation available this will be arranged via the Accommodation Team. Successful applicants will be contacted about accommodation.
- ✓ The Accommodation Team has a list of reputable letting agents within Ormskirk, if you are having difficulty arranging private accommodation, you can contact them at [accommodation@edgehill.ac.uk](mailto:accommodation@edgehill.ac.uk) for further guidance.

## Visa Requirements

- ✓ **Short-Term Visitor Visa** is required for students who will be studying at Edge Hill University for 6 months or less, this can usually be obtained on arrival to the UK by providing the Acceptance Letter we will provide you with, however some nationalities need to apply for this prior to arrival. - ✓ **Study Visa** is required for students who will study at Edge Hill University for a Full Academic Year *Offer Letters and CAS Statements are produced by the International Admissions team and sent directly to the students' email address.*

## Edge Hill grading system

Numerical Marks	Degree Classification
70% or higher	First class
60-69%	Upper Second Class (2:1)
50-59%	Lower Second Class (2:2)
40-49%	Third Class
0-39%	Fail
