The School of Education at NUI Galway invites applications for the Master of Education (MEd) programme.

Start Date: September 2017.

Duration: Two years, part-time. Classes will take place on Wednesday evenings (5-9pm) with additional sessions during school mid-term breaks and potentially during other holidays.

Entry requirements:

Those eligible to apply will have:

- A degree at level 8; and
- A teaching qualification (or equivalent)

In addition, a minimum of two-three years teaching experience, or relevant professional experience in education, will normally be required.

Programme Description:

In year one of the MEd, students complete six modules which include elements of the Educational Sciences and Professional Studies. In year two, the taught research methodology module is specifically designed to equip participants with the necessary research skills to enable students to complete a minor research thesis. Teaching and learning strategies include lectures, workshops, tutorials and seminars. With participants from a wide range of educational contexts and disciplines, the M.Ed. offers a dynamic learning environment that aims to foster collaborative learning. Assessment consists of coursework assignments and a minor thesis.
