Dr. Finch's presentation will be followed by a response and comments from Fearghas Ó Béara, Head of the European Parliament Liaison Office in Ireland, drawing on his experience within the European Parliamentary Research Service developing a culture of foresight to be rolled out across the European Parliament administration, feeding into political and legislative decision-making.
