If you are a Visiting Student wishing to take **FR111 French Language 2x**, please note this is not a Beginners' level; students will have completed 5 years at secondary school and completed one semester at the university. This semester 2 module is for visiting international students. This module aims to develop students' spoken and written skills in order to bring their proficiency in French from Level A2 to Level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Students will be engaging with a range of oral, aural, translation and written exercises.

The **core hours** for the FR111 module are the following:

- **Grammar Lecture:** Monday 12pm – M. O Tnuthail Theatre
- **Language Class 1:** grammar exercises – Tuesday 10am (group and venue to be assigned in due course)
- **Language Class 2:** comprehension / translation – Wednesday 10am (group and venue to be assigned in due course)
- **Language Class 3** - conversation – Wed 11am or Thurs 11am or Thurs 4pm
