Application after Nomination

Application from students	After nomination by a partner institution, students will submit their application information through KIMAS. (Kobe University International Student Management System) Each student will receive the URL and application guidelines by email after our nomination periods. Please note that the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) application process, which is required to obtain a Japanese student visa, has been implemented. Students who do not receive any email in the expected period are advised to check their e-mail folders including SPAM or advertisement mailbox because it could fail to reach the main mailbox. ■ Application information to be submitted online through KIMAS. 1. Exchange Student Personal Information 2. Copy of Academic Transcript in English (issued by your home university) 3. CV (free format) ■ Complete the COE online application through KIMAS. The applicants will be requested to upload the following materials for the COE application; 1. Digital ID Photo The ID photo should be taken within the last 3 months. The photo must meet all specifications with the instruction. The photo must be not same as the one used for your passport. 2. Passport ID Page 3. Proof of Financial Support in English or Japanese Bank balance certificate of yourself or your financial supporter. If you receive a scholarship grant as your financial support, please submit an official scholarship certificate in English proving the amount and period that you receive it. Once your application is completed, we will apply for the COE on your behalf, and your COE will be issued in around 1 to 3 months depending on the congestion of the immigration office. As soon as receiving your COE, we will email it to you. Please contact the nearby Japanese embassy or consulate for the visa application after receiving your COE. Please note that submitting the COE application will not guarantee your acceptance to the exchange program of Kobe University in Japan.

National Health Insurance (JPY 2,000/month) The National Health Insurance System in Japan reduces individuals' medical costs. 2. Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (PAS) (JPY 1,000) covers accidents and injuries during University events and classes. 3. Comprehensive Insurance for Student's Lives Coupled with PAS for International (JPY 1,110 or more, depending on the package selected) This covers accidents that can happen during your daily life including off-campus. 4. Inbound Medical Assistance Service (IMAS) (JPY 1,980) The medical assistance service during your stay in Kobe.
Vaccination	Kobe University has adopted the Measles and Rubella Registration Policy, and all newly enrolled students must submit a certificate demonstrating inoculation and an antibody test against measles and rubella at the medical check-up held at Kobe University. Those who do not have certificates are required to take an antibody test in Japan.
Medical Support Consultation	For students with chronic conditions and disabilities (physical, developmental, or mental), if you let us know <u>in advance</u> , we will make preparations to support your medical needs, if any, during your stay.
