Meabhraíonn an lá seo dúinn uilig in Ollscoil na Gaillimhe cad é cuspóir na hOllscoile.

Glacadh leis na chéad mhic léinn san Ollscoil seo sa bhliain 1849. Ó shin i leith, tá a gcuid ardoideachais faighte ag os cionn 128,000 céimí san Ollscoil seo, oideachas den scoth, mar is léir ó na poist ghradamacha atá bainte amach acu ní hamháin in Éirinn ach ar fud an domhain.
