



Fearaim fáilte roimh chairde agus roimh mhuintir na mac léinn a bhfuil cáilíochtaí á mbronnadh orthu inniu ar an lá fíorspeisialta seo agus déanaim comhghairdeas leo go léir. Meabhráonn an lá seo dúinn uilig in Ollscoil na Gaillimhe cad é cuspóir na hOllscoile.

Ó bunaíodh í sa bhliain 1845, tá a gcuid ardoideachais faighte ag os cionn 135,000 céimí san Ollscoil seo. Oideachas den scoth ba ea é seo, mar is léir ó na poist ghradamacha atá bainte amach acu agus an cion atá déanta acu le himeachta na mblianta go dtí an lá atá inniu ann, ní hamháin in Éirinn ach ar fud an domhain.

Inniu tá céim á bronnadh ort in ollscoil atá báite i dtroidisiún agus i stair. Bunaíodh Ollscoil na Gaillimhe sa bhliain 1845 mar aon le péire eile de Choláistí na Banríona, is iad sin Béal Feirste agus Corcaigh, agus chuir na chéad mhic léinn túis lena gcuid staidéir anseo sa bhliain 1849. Le 179 bliain anuas, d'oiríomar go dian dícheallach chun a chinntíú go mbíonn an t-oideachas is fearr faigte ag ár gcéimithe agus iad ag tabhairt faoin saol go mbeidh ar a gcumas tionchar dearfach láithreach a imirt ar an tsochaí agus ar an domhan.
