<b>Midwifery</b>	Examining a pregnant abdomen at the end stages of Labour and observing and assisting in and a simulated birth.
<b>Nursing</b>	A deteriorating patient – recording vital signs and administering treatments
<b>Medicine</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Examination of an abdomen and preparation for surgery</li><li>• Endoscopy – looking inside the gut</li><li>• Orthopaedics – An overview of common orthopaedic sport injuries and common pathologies. A match the device/implant to the disease challenge.</li><li>• General Practice – Taking a medical history, doing a clinical examination, diagnosing a patient with chest pain.</li></ul>
<b>Paramedics</b>	Pre-hospital care with the National Ambulance Service. Managing a fracture and using splints
<b>Allied Health Professions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Speech and Language Therapy – Exploring the ways S&amp;L therapists help children and adults with language, communication and eating difficulties.</li><li>• Occupational Therapy- Time use and occupational balance</li><li>• Podiatry – foot pulses, plantar foot pressures and examining diseases of the foot.</li></ul>
<b>Pharmacy</b>	Step into the role of a pharmacist, solving simulated real-world patient cases and discovering the broad range of roles a Pharmacist can work in
